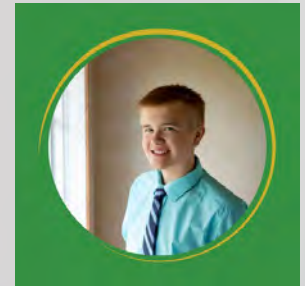
Who is eligible to apply?

- (1) entering juniors or seniors in college. You must have
completed at least 60 credit hours, for most institutions, to
be classified a junior. If at the end of this current
semester, or after summer school you have at least 60
credit hours, you are eligible.
- (2) enrolled in a qualifying vocational/associate program.

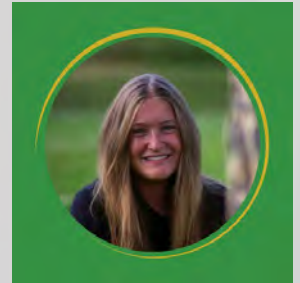
